Ancient History

"borrowed" from Tom Martin's Book "Fairfield Glade History (1986)

- Thomas "Big Foot" Spencer one of the first settlers in 1778
- Local wagon trails became the famous Walton Stage Road in 1801
- Militia escorted travelers, passing through Crab Orchard in those early days
- Became Cumberland County in 1856 with Crab Orchard the largest community but Crossville selected as the capital due to its central location
- "Older residents enjoy recalling that Crossville had hogs rooting in its muddy streets long after the Crab Orchard was a thriving operation"
- The Tennessee Central Railroad was built around 1900



RE: History of Fairfield Name

Neal Simonson and George (Jake) Jacobus were original "founders" of Fairfield Communities. They had been friends since grade school and were partners in a construction company at Fort Smith, Arkansas when they purchased the land surrounding Greers Ferry Lake in Arkansas (now known as Fairfield Bay) in 1966.

According to Allene Meadors (Mr. Jacobus's administrative assistant of more than 23 years), "we had everybody in the world sending in names for Jake and Neal's new company". On one occasion when Neal had returned home to New Jersey for a visit, he made a call to Jake from a telephone booth in Fairfield. New Jersey (now you know the rest of the story).



Fire Department

- The Fairfield Glade Fire Department was formed in 1974
- By early 1976, the fire and security building was completed, a 750 gallon fire engine had been acquired and the roster of volunteers numbered 25.


Police Department

- Public Safety Department created in the 1970s or 1980s
- New Baptist Church broke ground in June 2011
- Chief Williams took office in June of 2015
- The Fairfield Glade Police Department was formed in January 2017
- Moved into new building on Peavine Road 2018(?)
- A staff of 15 sworn officers, 3 civilian staff and 7 volunteer auxiliary
- Chief Kate Self took office in May of 2022

The Magnificent Sycamore

- In 1864, Hugh Center, son of Thomas Center, planted a small sycamore tree switch he harvested from the shore along Daddy's Creek
- On October 5, 2012, the sycamore tree received it's official declaration as a Historical and Legendary tree in the state of Tennessee.
- The sycamore tree measures 96 ft. high, 165 ft. crown spread and the trunk is 16 ft. around.

Art Guild

- Because of the distance to Crossville-Peavine Road was winding and treacherous-they decided to start their own art guild here at the Glade.
- The Fairfield Glade Fine Arts Guild was officially born and named October 12, 1978 at its first organizational meeting.
- The Fine arts Guild moved into its "new building" on Wilshire Heights in September of 1982 and promptly held its first Art Show.
- 1982 The Art Guild became an official non-profit organization.
- 1994 with membership over 80, the Art Guild had all but outgrown its facility and voted to hold further meetings at the Multi-Purpose Building.
- 2008 Plateau Creative Arts Center opened for business in their current building
